3. What is the difference between knowing about God and knowing God?
4. How would someone passionately pursue knowing Christ? How will you pursue Him this week?
5. What are some things a person who really wants to know God might do to get to know Him more?
6. Who do you know that has walked away from Christ because they were raised in church but didn't really know Jesus? What can you do to reach out to that person this week? What can you do to keep from becoming like that?
7. Have you given Jesus more your heart or your head? How would you want the answer to that question to be different a week from now?
8. Kyle mentioned a story about a "prodigal" daughter who left Christ. What does the word "prodigal" refer to? What have you learned about God through that story? (See Luke 15:11-32)

Group Challenge

Challenge your group to spend this week in passionate pursuit of knowing Jesus. Have each one commit to some action they will take to pursue knowing Christ more—starting a Bible reading plan, praying each morning, listening to worship music in the place of their regular playlist—not some deed to impress God, but something to grow closer to Him.
